Video Series Communications Campaign

The Hunt Institute launched a communications campaign designed to help increase knowledge and awareness about college and career readiness, implementation challenges and successes for English Language Learners (ELL), and the benefits of inquiry-based learning through a highly-anticipated video series. The videos provide insights into parent engagement and awareness of the Common Core State Standards (CCSS); the shift in science education instructional practices; CCSS mathematics; and preparing ELLs for success in college and careers.

The first video series was developed in partnership with the National PTA and released in **June 2014**. It consists of three videos and 10 vignettes presenting the voices of teachers, school leaders, students, parents, and policymakers discussing the value, benefits, and need for higher standards. The videos are accompanied by a comprehensive toolkit and were disseminated among PTA's 24,000 local units and four-million members across the country. The videos are posted on PTA's website and The Institute's *YouTube* channel.

The second series - Hands On, Minds Open: The Changing Face of Science Education - documents how leading K-12 educators are shifting their instructional practices to advance the critical thinking skills demanded in today's economy, while increasing interest in science. Four videos, highlighting teachers in North Carolina, provide educators, parents and policymakers with a stronger understanding of how science instruction is transforming to better engage students and prepare them for success in a global economy. The video series is accompanied by a user guide and an issue brief – Making the Case: The Importance of a Rigorous Science Education (April 2014 issue). There is also a special case insert – Moving Forward: State Engagement with the Next Generation Science Standards. July 2014

The third video series was developed as part of a post-event effort for the **Readiness Matters/State Collaboration for Success** conference, co-hosted by The Hunt Institute, the National Council of La Raza, and the Southern Regional Education Board on May 5-7, 2014 in Atlanta, GA. The videos were released in **August 2014**.

Early, in the following year, The Institute collaborated with the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics (NCTM) to produce another series of videos to enhance the understanding of the mathematics skills students need to succeed in college, life and careers. Beginning with mathematics in the primary grades, *Math Voices: Educators and Mathematicians Talk About College and Career Ready Standards and Improving Mathematics Teaching and Learning* addresses the importance of developing a solid foundation for algebra. It also covers the standards for mathematical practice and why conceptual understanding requires a different approach to teaching and learning. The series – released in *April* 2015 – consists of seven videos approximately five-six minutes long and eight video clips 20-30 seconds long. They were disseminated through a wide variety of Hunt Institute partner networks and other mathematics organizations. The videos can be found on The Institute's YouTube channel and the NCTM website.

Hunt-Kean Leadership Fellows

The Hunt-Kean Leadership Fellows Program was launched on **December 3-4, 2014** in Memphis, TN. The year-long program is designed to help participants achieve the next stage of growth for their careers by

strengthening their knowledge base in substantive education issues and providing useful tools to help Fellows position themselves into becoming effective education policy leaders and champions.

The two-day session focused on the importance of rigorous standards, aligned assessments, and accountability, as well as explore the topic of school choice. The gathering included sessions featuring a variety of well-known resource experts in education, policy, and politics. The highlight of the event was a panel discussion of former governors moderated by Gov. Jim Hunt sharing their insights on the education topics and their views on state leadership.

Holshouser Legislators Retreat

The annual Holshouser Legislators Retreat was held on January 12-13, 2015 in Greensboro, NC. More than 45 policymakers gathered to discuss *Education | For a Stronger North Carolina*, featuring engaging dialogue about the growing economic imperative for all North Carolina students to obtain a credential beyond a high school diploma and preparing them for the rigorous demands of a 21st century job market. The bipartisan event focused on issues of recruiting, training, and retaining outstanding educators; STEM education; early learning; building a culture of achievement; and rural schooling. Featured guests were Michael Horn, co-founder and executive director of education for the Clayton Christensen Institute; and Cheryl A. Oldham, vice president of education policy of the U.S. Chamber and vice president of education and workforce of the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Foundation. A number of national and state education resource experts also shared knowledge and expertise.
